

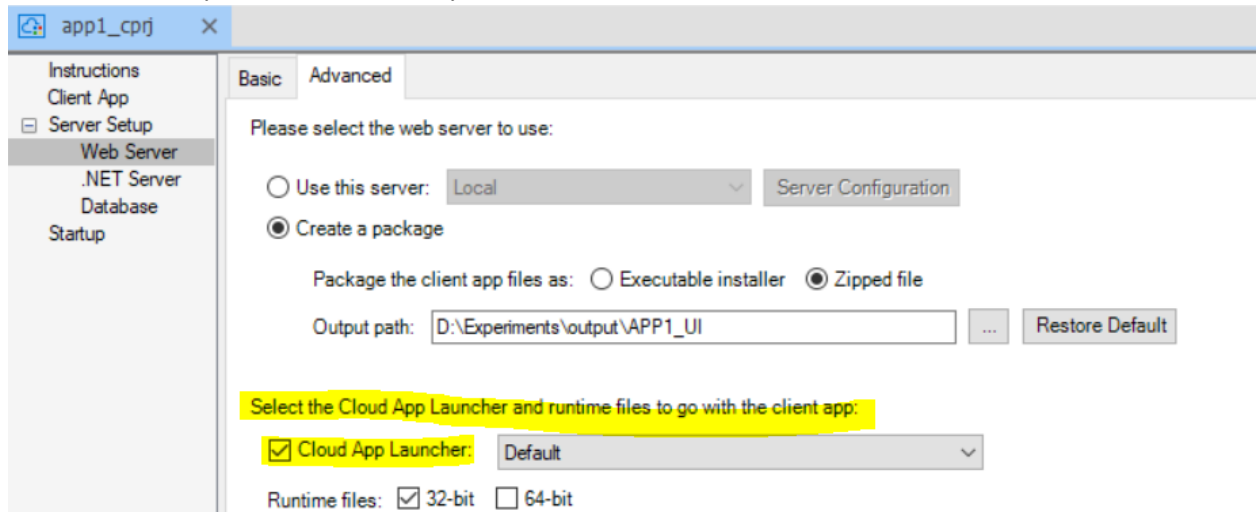
Powerbuilder version 2022 build 1900



PowerServer Auto build [PBAutoBuild220.exe] not packaging Cloud App Launcher files in the Zip file

Steps:

1. Create test application
2. Added PowerServer Build file and created the build.
3. Build successfully created without any error



4. Zip file contains the following files

APP1_UI > app1_Installer.zip > CloudAppPublisher > CloudAppInstall 22.0

5. Export the Build file (.json)
6. Create the same application build using **PBAutoBuild220** with exported build Json file

"C:\Program Files (x86)\Appeon\PowerBuilder 22.0\PBAutoBuild220.exe" /f app1_cprj.json /l powerserver_app1_deploy.log /le powerserver_app1_error.log /lu powerserver_app1_unsupport.log

7. Successful build creation without any error.

Note: Build files will have only runtime libraries and not included Cloud App Install 22.0 files.
